AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHOOL

The aim of the institution is to bring the pupils an all round education, academics, Moral social Values and physical activities based on high ideals and principles. The pupils are expected to play their part in the life and to appreciate true refinement and culture, especially the culture of our own country. But above all stress is laid on good conduct, character formation, commitment to justice, liberation of the poor and the oppressed.

THE MOTTO 'EDUCATION FOR PERFECTION'

The definition of a 'School of Education for Perfection' rests upon the two terms, 'school' and 'perfection'. While 'school' points up to regrouping of discipline to promote flexibility in curriculum that can make education suit the need, ability and means of learner, 'Perfection' emphasizes the refusal to compromise on quality as it shall be evident in the advancement of knowledge. The motto therefore is an invitation to keep striving for the best, for excellence in studies and all other training imparted or received. So, when a Xavierian leaves school after Std X, he/ she is ready to face the world with a proficient personality, strong values and confidence.

THE STAFF

The school is proud to have qualified and dedicated staff, trained to mould the young minds in academics as well as co-curricular activities. Teachers are carefully selected to meet the demands of modern techniques of teaching in the Montessori, Primary and High School Level.

ADMISSION

Before seeking admission for his/ her ward in the school, the parents/ guardians are expected to go through the various rules given in the school prospectus.



Admission is given only on the basis of merit. Students seeking admission are required to appear an entrance examination. Entrance Examination is conducted for all T.C. holders from a recognized English Medium School. T.C. from other states should be countersigned by Educational Authorities of that state. Aadhar Card of the students and parents are necessary. PAN Number is mandatory for the transfer students.

The following documents should be produced at the time of admission :

A Photo copy of the Birth Certificate along with the Original one to verify for admission to Montessori classes and Std - I.

Transfer Certificates of the school last attended, for Std - II & above.

The Progress Report of the child indicating his/ her academic performance and participation in the co-curricular activities in the school last attended.

WITHDRAWAL

Before withdrawing a student, a calendar month's notice in writing is to be given by the parent.

A transfer certificate will be issued only if all the dues have been paid and library books returned.

If a child is once withdrawn, the admission fee must be paid again for readmission.

FEE RULES

School Fees and Bus Fees are payable for full 12 months of the year.

Term Fees will be charged once in a year and must be paid at the beginning of the term as given on the fee card.

Tuition Fees and Other Fees will be increased every year.

Fees must be paid before 15th of each month. In case of default, a fine of Rs. 25/- will be charged per month.

Fees must be paid by Cheque or Bar Code.

A child's name may be struck off the school roll for non-payment of school dues after two months. On payment of the admission fees only, the child's name will be enrolled again.

Only those pupils who have paid all school fees are permitted to appear for the regular examination.

UNIFORMS

**For Girls - Beige pleated pinafore, white and beige striped blouse, Beige socks with two brown stripes, Black shoes (Bata) Chocolate brown belt and tie (KG Section - Bows)
Hair must be either tied in two plaits with white ribbons or cut short above the collar and worn with a white hair band.
Expensive jewellery and big earrings are not allowed.**



- For Boys - LKG to Std V - Beige Half Pant & Shirt with Beige Stripes, Socks with Brown Stripes, Brown Belt and tie (KG Section - Bows)**
Std - VI to Std - X - Full Pant & Shirt with Beige stripes, socks with brown stripes. All boys must have crew cut except Sikh students. Black Shoes (Bata), chocolate brown belt and tie.
- N.B. : Students from LKG and UKG must wear bows. Students from Std - I to X must wear ties. Chocolate brown Pull over with two cream stripes on the neck and cuffs.**
- In Winter : LKG to Std IV - A pull over as specified by the school
 Std - V to Std - X - Blazer as specified by the school**
- Saturday : White dress, White canvas shoes only with white socks for Both boys and girls from Std - VI to Std - X**
- Thursday : White dress, White canvas shoes only with white socks for Both boys and girls from Std - I to Std - V**

PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

In order to attain the high standard which the school intends to maintain, the co-operation of parents is required. The best of school training is seriously crippled unless the contribution of the home atmosphere does its part.

Parents are kindly requested to study all the rules of the school carefully and abide by them faithfully and also have them observed by their children.

Parents and guardians are requested not to walk into the classroom or interview teachers during school hours. Those who want to know the progress of their child can kindly meet the teachers with the prior appointment. Parents are expected to co-operate in the work of the Pupil enforcing regularity and discipline, by taking a general interest in their

child's progress.

Parents should check the Diary daily and note the teacher's remarks etc.

Complaints, if any may be addressed to the Principal/ Head Mistress directly.

Kindly acknowledge all school circulars regarding fees, co-curricular programmes, parents-teachers meeting, examination etc. and comply with the instructions given in the same.

Parents/ Guardians are particularly requested to see the Principal's and Teacher's Remarks column in the students diary and do the needful.

Please do not take the child out for long holidays during the school working days.

Pupils will be granted leave of absence for unavoidable circumstances only if the application is addressed to the Principal/ Class teacher and signed by the parent/ guardian.

RULES AND DISCIPLINE

On class days and at school functions the children are expected to wear the uniform prescribed.

Fine will be imposed in case of any damage within the school premises.

Students should not wear ornaments to school.

Change of residence and telephone numbers should be notified to the school.

No magazines, papers or books other than the text books should be brought to school without the Principal's permission.

Private tuitions from our own school teachers are discouraged.

All the students are required to speak in English in the School campus.

A fine of Rs. 50/- will be imposed for not speaking in English.

Each Student should possess more than one set of uniform to ensure neatness in school.

Students should be careful not to throw paper, plastic bags etc anywhere in the school premises.

SPECIAL RULES

To be eligible to appear the Annual Examination, 75 % attendance is compulsory except on medical grounds.

Repeated absence without on leave or unexplained absence for more than 15 consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/ her name struck off the rolls. Admission may be granted only on payment of fresh admission fees.

A student failing twice in the same class shall have to leave the school.

Relatives and friends of the students are not allowed to visit them during school hours, without the prior permission of the Principal.

Parents are requested not to disturb the teachers and the management staffs at their residence or over phone regarding school matters.

Students availing school bus services will not get the same if they shift the residence in the mid-session to the areas to which our school buses do not ply.
